The Joint Foreign Chambers of the Philippines would like to express their support for Senate Bill 741 and House Bill 3079 that call for a ban on the use of asbestos.



At present, there are 19 manufacturing companies importing raw asbestos and five distributors of asbestos-containing products registered with the Environmental Management Bureau of the Department of Energy and Natural Resources.

As you have stated in your proposed Bill 741, 40 countries have banned the use of Asbestos due to the question of its safety and the diseases it causes when people are exposed. The Philippines should be counted as one of the countries that must ban the use of Asbestos.
